Call to Order: Chair Yamashita-Lopez called the meeting to order at 1:31 p.m.

Review and Approval of the June 20, 2017 Board Meeting Minutes: On a motion made by Director Bradbury, seconded by Secretary Michalko, the June 20, 2017 board meeting minutes were unanimously approved, as submitted.

<u>Chair's Report:</u> Chair Yamashita-Lopez welcomed Director Rick Cook to the Board and thanked him for his participation. Chair Yamashita-Lopez reported that she continues to assist Averydale Mutual Water Company with various matters; she added that the meeting with the State Attorney General's Office regarding the Chrom6 case was a success.

Executive Director's Report: Managing Director Peralta Gailey reported that staff is working to add a new feature to the website that will allow members to search for services provided by affiliate members. Managing Director Peralta Gailey also reported that communications to members continues to excel the industry standard; she added that she is working on engaging a photographer to take head shots of board members for the September in person board meeting.

<u>Committee Chairs' Report</u>: Vice President Armstrong reported that the legislative committee would be convening the following day, Wednesday, July 19th, by phone to discuss the legislative water bond proposals, the conservation proposal and SB 623 - a bill that may implement a "public goods charge" on water service. Chair Yamashita-Lopez added that she, Vice President Armstrong and staff will be working on the development of legislative policy principles. Director Ken Tcheng reported that the regulatory affairs would also be convening by phone the following day, Wednesday, July 19th, to discuss various regulatory matters including; (1) 1,2,3-TCP, (2) Chrom6, (3) Perchlorate, and (4) AB 401 – Low Income Water Rate Assistance Program.

Budget Report: Treasurer Evangelista provided an overview of the demand sheet. On a motion made by Director Bradbury, seconded by Director Nunneley, the demand sheet was unanimously approved.
