California Association of Mutual Water Companies (CalMutuals) Board of Directors Meeting Minutes February 21, 2017

Call to Order: Chair Yamashita-Lopez called the meeting to order at 2:05 p.m.

<u>Present:</u> Lisa Yamashita-Lopez (Director, President & Chair), Dave Armstrong (Director, Vice President), Dave Michalko (Director, Secretary), Doug Nunneley (Director), Ken Tcheng (Director), Adan Ortega (Staff, Executive Director), Denise Peralta Gailey (Staff, Managing Director), Myra Evangelista (Staff, Treasurer), Jim Ciampa (Legal Counsel), Lynda Noriega.

Absent: Jim Byerrum (Director), Ken Bradbury (Director).

Chairman's Report: President Yamashita-Lopez discussed adding a classifieds section to the news alerts as a benefit for members who wish to buy and/or sell equipment, and other related needs. No objection was raised.. President Yamashita-Lopez asked for volunteers to travel to Sacramento for meetings with legislators, Director Tcheng volunteered to attend and represent CalMutuals; they will be joined by Vice President Armstrong, Director Byerrum, and Executive Director Ortega. President Yamashita Lopez then asked for the Board to submit the names of any general managers that would make great additions to the Board. President Yamashita-Lopez requested that the next Board meeting take place in person – Director Tcheng and Lynda Noriega volunteered to host the meeting at their offices. She added that staff will work to coordinate the details. President Yamashita-Lopez informed the Board that she will be sharing a document on frequently asked questions regarding lead sampling in schools to review and utilize if needed. Managing Director Gailey asked for approval to also share the frequently asked questions document with the members and President Yamashita-Lopez stated that would be fine. President Yamashita-Lopez then asked for input regarding the budget & finance committee which was chaired by former Director Ken Deck. After some deliberation, the Board decided to not continue the committee's meetings; President Yamashita-Lopez asked that Staff communicate the change with Bob Fan who serves on the committee.

Executive Director's Report: Executive Director Ortega reported that the planning for the trip to Sacramento to meet with legislators is being finalized. He added that on February 28th, he will be joined by President Yamashita-Lopez, Secretary Michalko and Director Byerrum in Ventura County at a meeting with various mutual water company directors and general managers to discuss CalMutuals and the benefits of joining CalMutuals JPRIMA.

<u>Committee Chairs' Report</u>: Director Ken Tcheng reported that the regulatory affairs committee convened on Tuesday, January 21, 2017 and discussed: (1) Hexavalent Chromium; (2) 1,2,3- TCP; (3) Perchlorate; (4) AB 401 – Low Income Water Rate Assistance; (5) Executive Order B-37-16 (6) Human Right to Water Web Portal, and (7) Lead Testing in Schools. He added that the committee will continue to monitor all regulatory matters and report to the Board as needed. Vice President Armstrong reported that the deadline for legislators to submit bills was Friday, February 17, 2017 as a result; legislation that was introduced is currently being reviewed for any potential impacts to mutual water companies. He added that the legislative committee will be meeting on March 1, 2017 and the visit to Sacramento will be taking place on March 7, 2017.

Demand Sheet: Staff Member Evangelista provided an overview of the demand sheet. On a motion made by Secretary Michalko, seconded by Vice President Armstrong, the demand sheet was unanimously approved.

Financial Statements: Staff Member Evangelista disseminated and reviewed the financial statements. No additional comments or questions were made.

<u>2017 Annual Meeting:</u> President Yamashita-Lopez stated that due to scheduling conflicts, the date for the annual meeting has not been finalized but did state that the Board may wish to move forward with Friday, June 2, 2017 and that Vice President Armstrong has agreed to manage the meeting in her absence. After some deliberation, the Board agreed to move forward with Friday, June 2, 2017; more details to follow.

Director Comments: None.

Adjourn: Chair Yamashita-Lopez adjourned the meeting at 2:39 p.m.
